

NORTHERN BEACHES ARTIST IN RESIDENCE 2022 ERAMBOO

GUIDELINES

Northern Beaches Council and Eramboo Artist Environment are offering a six-month Artist Residency in 2021. This residency provides a unique experience for a Northern Beaches or Sydney based artist/ group collaboration, to research, experiment and develop new work.

The successful applicant will work closely with Eramboo and Northern Beaches Council to share their learnings/work with local audiences. The successful applicant will also be required to undertake a mentorship aspect of the residency. This could include delivering a masterclass, a series of workshops or one-to-one mentoring of a local (NB LGA) emerging artist.

OBJECTIVES

This residency aims to:

- Support the professional development of local artists/ creatives
- Showcase, build partnership and celebrate arts venues in the Northern Beaches
- Connect our community with innovative and authentic cultural expression
- Foster cross-cultural networks and partnerships
- Support the development of new work
- Provide mentorship/skill sharing opportunities for established artists to connect with the local creative community
- Increase engagement with established artists to support the growth of Northern Beaches creative sector
- To activate and foster creative professional development at Eramboo Artist Environment
- To foster a dialogue between art and environment, as well as culture and nature within the Northern Beaches community

ERAMBOO ARTIST ENVIRONMENT

Eramboo Artist Environment is progressing to the fore of contemporary artistic production. Located at 304 McCarrs Creek Road, Terrey Hills, Eramboo offers affordable non-residential/residential studio and exhibition space to emerging and established creative practitioners.

The focus of Eramboo Artist Environment is on contemporary arts, including but not limited to painting, sculpture, photography, filmmaking, design, sound, music and digital media.

The artist in residence will have exclusive access to studio 6, seven days a week during the residency period. Neighbouring studios will be occupied, allowing the selected artist the opportunity to connect with a broader community of creative practitioners.

OUTCOMES

Artists are expected to produce three key outcomes:

- Community engagement (share their learnings/work with local audiences)
- Mentorship component (could include delivering a masterclass, workshops or one-to-one mentoring of a local artist (NB LGA))
- Production and showcase of work/ body of work (exhibition/performance and or temporary public works) within the grounds of Eramboo.

The successful applicant will articulate a plan for how they plan to showcase their body of work, how they will engage with the community and provide mentoring to a local artist/ wider audience.

RESOURCES PROVIDED

- Mentoring and artistic development support
- Promotional and marketing support
- Financial grant support - \$3000 (to include all cost for delivery of the art project)

ELIGIBILITY

- Resident of Northern Beaches Council or Sydney based artists.
- Commitment to utilise the studio regularly (minimum 15 hours per week)
- Not be a previous Eramboo Artist in Resident
- Willingness to work to professional standards and checks (insurance, safety etc)
- Successful applicant will enter into an agreement with program partners

ASSESSMENT

Applications will be assessed on:

- Strength of artist's plan for residency
- Strength/innovation of artist's proposed outcome(s)
- Evidence of capacity to execute end project
- Quality of artist's work to date
- Value of the studio to the development of the individual artist
- Suitability of art form for the studio
- Identified strategies to connect with the community/ audiences

Applications will be assessed by a panel of arts and cultural representatives from Eramboo Artist Environment, Northern Beaches Council and community.
