# Important information regarding Warringah Aquatic

## What happens if I can not attend lessons?

Absences - if you notify the office prior to your lesson you will be granted make-ups. Make-ups must be booked via the office, are subject to availability and must be used within the current session - maximum of 2 make-ups per session. If due to illness - on presentation of a Doctor's Certificate you may receive either a credit or an additional make-up.

## How do we re-enrol for the next session?

The onus is on the customer to re-book their swim lessons - they do not continue automatically. All current swimmers have first priority to rebook their places for the next session.

Rebooking for the following session commences four weeks prior to the end of the current session. An email with session and rebooking details will be sent to you and signs will be posted around the centre. Please note these dates as classes are not held unless full payment is made. If your contact details change please notify the office or essential information may not be received.

## Upset children

Our aim is to make swimming a fun and enjoyable experience for your child.

If your child is upset? A certain amount of crying is to be expected from most beginners and is totally acceptable. Crying can be a natural expression to a new class experience in the water and/or separation from you. Our Supervisor will always consult with you in regards to your child.

## Duty of care

Children under 10 years must be accompanied by an adult. Children are not permitted into the LTS area prior to the start of their class.

Our instructor's Duty of Care does not commence until the swimmer is in their class and ends when the class is complete. Parents must collect their children from the LTS area at the conclusion of their lesson.
