

BACKGROUND

This month we were saddened to hear of the passing of Allan Hale, OAM who many will remember for his incredible services to the community through Kaddy Transport for many decades.

Allan began working with Kaddy back in 1983 as a driver providing community transport for those with disabilities and then went on to become Chairman, a position he held for many more years. He was still serving on the Board after standing down as Chairman some years back and I understand that Allan never missed a board meeting in all that time until very recently. I think this demonstrates the extraordinary dedication he had to the Kaddy Transport organisation and to their clients.

He was formally recognised in 2013 and received a Member of the Order of Australia Award for his distinguished services to the community, particularly to people with a disability. He also gave generously of his time as a volunteer with the Salvation Army.

For those of us fortunate to have met Allan, you will recall his determination to ensure that those in the community who needed assistance were cared for. I only learned recently too of his own personal contributions to the organisation and to his clients. Nothing was ever too much trouble for him and he always went beyond the role of a volunteer to assist the many clients fortunate to have Allan in their lives.

He will be greatly missed by his colleagues at Kaddy Transport and the many members of the community who he has assisted over the years.

Our thoughts are with his family and friends at this very difficult and sad time and on behalf of my fellow Councillors and the Northern Beaches community, I extend our deepest sympathies.
