At 11am on the 11th of November 1918 the guns on the Western front fell silent. This moment is forever marked as Remembrance Day - a significant opportunity for us all to remember those who have given their lives in wars and conflicts across the world.

Council is hosting two events in remembrance at Manly Dam and on The Manly Corso on Monday and there are a number of other events being held across the Beaches.

The Harbord RSL sub-Branch and the Soldiers Avenue of Honour Stakeholders Group are also hosting a family event to mark the centenary of Soldiers Ave at Jacka Park in Freshwater tomorrow from 10am.

Have you seen the makeover of the clubhouse and amenities block at North Narrabeen Rockpool? The \$700,000 upgrade includes a refreshed external appearance, undercover seating, a family change room and kitchen - a great improvement on the old block and a much better space for both the community and the members of the local swimming clubs.

Manly Lagoon - temporary bank stabilisation works

Commencing Mon 11 Nov

We'll renourish and stabilise the eroding southern bank using sand in the channel, west of the bridge. There will be temporary fencing in front of the foreshore from today, but access will be available on weekends. Weather permitting, works will be completed in three weeks. Stockpiled sand may become darker and smell as it dries. This will fade over time.

Pittwater Development Control Plan (DCP) amendments

At its meeting on Tue 22 Oct, Council approved amendments to the Pittwater

DCP to update references to legislation and provide additional cross-referencing relating to Water Management, and to revise requirements for the surfacing of driveways.
