Hop, Skip and Jump Bus Service Code of Conduct

Passengers can:

- Expect the bus to be clean and tidy
- Expect to easily see the driver's authority card displayed
- Expect the driver to behave with dignity towards them
- Expect the driver to comply with reasonable requests

Our code of respect for passengers includes:

- No standing on the bus
- Must not threaten, harass or attempt to intimidate other person
- No offensive language or behaveing offensively
- No eating or drinking allowed on the bus
- No smoking
- No vandalism
- No graffiti
- No surfboards or other large objects when the bus is full
- Only animals with a valid Transport for NSW issued Animal Assistance Permit will be permitted to travel on the bus. Please note:
 - The animal must be under the control of the registered handler at all times
 - Animals are not allowed on the seats and must not obstruct passageways
 - Drivers may refuse to allow to animals if it is not clean or appears vicious
